

Get Planting

PLAN



- Define the purpose of your planting project
- Set a realistic budget and timeframe
- Identify your key goals — water quality, shelter, biodiversity, erosion control, carbon, amenity, or land retirement
- Select the right plant species for your site conditions

PREP



- Identify weeds, gorse or difficult vegetation

From plant supply coordination to planting crews, Kūmānu can help get larger planting projects in the ground at the right time.

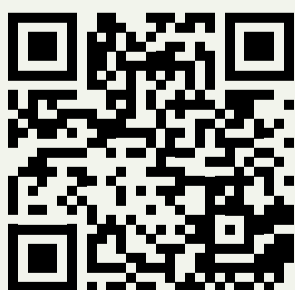
CARE
